

INTRACLUB COMPETITION RULES

1. The first name in each section on the competition sheet shall be the challenger, the second shall be the opponent.
2. The challenger must contact the opponent to arrange a mutually agreeable date for the match.
3. Matches may be played after 11.00 am and all competitors must wear grey/white.
4. The challenger shall draw out of the bag for a rink but no competitor may play on the same rink twice in any day under penalty of disqualification.
5. In singles the challenger shall provide a competent marker who shall be approved by the opponent .The marker must not be a relative of either player, but must be a member of the club and adhere to the grey/white dress code.
6. Two trial ends may be played.
7. In the event of bad weather or green conditions stopping a competition match, it shall be resumed on a mutually agreeable date.
8. Please arrange to play all match rounds by 20th August to allow time for trophies to be engraved for presentation on Finals Day.
9. Please abide by the rules to ensure the smooth running of the competitions.
10. In case of dispute, contact the Competition Secretary/s, whose decision shall be final.
